What We Do Now

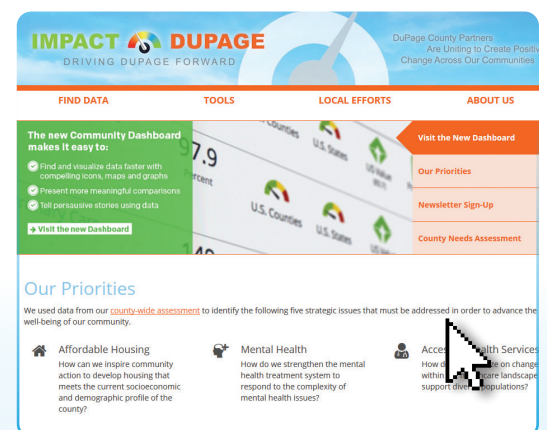
- Centralized location for data and resources

Sessions will be offered in English and in Spanish.
