- Share successes to promote a culture of collaboration



Priority Area	Action Plan Partners	What are we working to achieve?	How will we do it?
Prevention and Management of Serious Illness	DuPage Health Coalition Health Equity and Access Response Team (HEART)	Build an equitable, personcentered healthcare system that is efficient and effective, creates meaningful access to care for all and demonstrably improves health status by: Increase ability to address social determinants of health/drivers of health. Raise awareness of equity issues, chronic disease, and serious illness. Improve access to chronic disease screenings and management/improving access to primary care.	 Launch survey to health and hospital systems to understand who they are screening for drivers of health/social determinants of health. Host or support others in HEART in holding 3 community forums or other community events in relationship with those experiencing inequities. Hold 3 focus groups to seek community feedback about areas of opportunity and need; engage partners and their networks to invite feedback and participation in future coalition activities. Host 3 "Take Charge of Your Diabetes" classes. Sessions will be offered in English and in Spanish.
Mental Health and Substance Use	Behavioral Health Collaborative HOPE Taskforce Prevention Leadership Team	Strengthen prevention and treatment of behavioral health issues for residents of DuPage County by: Reducing access to drugs. Reducing opioid overdose deaths. Increase overdose response. Preventing and reducing youth substance use. Strengthening the availability of youth mental health services. Improve the coordination of co-occuring mental health and substance use disorder treatment. Raise community awareness of available options for mental health crisis response.	 Reduce drug access and misuse through drug takeback programs and safe prescribing training. Train first responders and bystanders to identify signs of opioid overdose and use naloxone to reverse the overdose. Expand access to medication-assisted treatment for opioid use disorder. Mass media compaigns about risks of alcohol and prescription drug misuse by teens.
